The Lower Alsace Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Thursday, September 22, 2016 at 6:30 P.M. in the Township Municipal Building, 1200 Carsonia Avenue, Reading, PA.

I. ATTENDANCE

Board members present: James Oswald and John Theodossiou. Todd Weikel was not present.

Also in attendance were Homer Williams, , Andy Shean and Dale Boyer along with Shawn Filby, President of the Exeter Library and Carole Duran from the Reading Eagle.

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 P.M. by the Chairman James Oswald and then followed with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

III. PUBLIC COMMENT

Shawn Filby presented a request for funding from the Exeter Library. The Supervisors thanked him for the information and indicated they would take it into consideration.

Dale Boyer, Township resident complained about the speeding on Byram Avenue and about the Township Per Capita Tax and the fees charged by Statewide Tax Service for delinquent collections.

IV. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

A motion to approve the minutes of the September 8, 2016 Lower Alsace Township Supervisors' Meeting was made by Supervisor Oswald, seconded by Supervisor Theodossiou and the motion carried.

V. TREASURER'S LIST OF BILLS

- A. Supervisor Theodossiou made a motion that was seconded by Supervisor Oswald and all approved a motion to approve payment of the list of bills from the General Fund in the amount of \$ 96,223.25 and \$1,945.25 from the Fire Tax Fund.
- B. A request for a \$1,000 contribution to purchase some replacement tot lot equipment at Carsonia Park from the Antietam Valley Parks Commission was approved by a motion made by Supervisor Oswald, seconded by Supervisor Theodossiou and all voted yes to approve the expense.

VI. NEW BUSINESS

- A. A motion was made by Supervisor Theodossiou, seconded by Supervisor Oswald and all voted yes to appoint Raymond Wertz – Mayer St. Reading to work as a seasonal Part-time employee for leaf collection. The hourly wage is set at \$11.00 per hour.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that all parents and guardians shall accompany their minor children during the Halloween night “Trick or Treat” journey on Monday, October 31, 2016 from 6:00 P.M. to 9:00 P.M.
