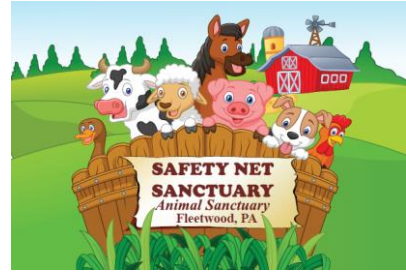

Safety Net Sanctuary will accept and care for stray or lost/escaped domestic animals originating from within the Township of Lower Alsace's borders and to work with the Township of Lower Alsace to coordinate retrieval and transport of such animals to Safety Net's sanctuary located at 187 Houck Road in Fleetwood PA. Animals accepted will include those brought to Safety Net Sanctuary by their agents, Township of Lower Alsace designated representatives, emergency service providers, dog wardens and/or citizens. Please call first as this is only a holding facility. Personal owner surrenders will be accepted only on a case by case basis dependent upon available space. Please call first.

Safety Net Sanctuary shall make all reasonable efforts to re-unite an animal brought to its shelter with its lawful owner(s), or, if that is not possible, to facilitate the adoption of the animal in the manner permitted by applicable law.

Safety Net is also grateful for donations of dog and cat food, blankets and towels. Also accepting Redner's store receipts, newspapers and cat litter.
